Notice of Executive Committee Workshop: Industry Input

The Solid Waste Disposal and Recyclable Materials Processing Authority of Broward County, Florida (Broward SWA) is a newly created entity, established through an interlocal agreement (ILA) initially signed by Broward County and 28 municipalities, to develop a coordinated regional solid waste and recycling master plan (Master Plan). The Master Plan is being prepared to guide the development of services, programs, and infrastructure that meets the region's solid waste management and recycling needs in an innovative, environmentally sustainable, and economically efficient manner over the next 40 years and beyond.

The Broward SWA recognizes that success depends, in part, on leveraging local, regional, and national service providers, utilizing existing infrastructure, and capitalizing on economies of scale, amongst many other factors, to achieve a successful integrated solid waste management system to manage solid waste, recyclable materials, construction and demolition debris, yard trash, bulk waste, and electronic waste generated within the ILA communities. Accordingly, the Broward SWA Executive Committee is hosting a public workshop (i.e., Industry Event) to engage with existing and potential private sector service providers to solicit feedback and input to inform the preparation of its Master Plan. The Broward SWA will host additional workshops in the future that will allow for input from other stakeholders on components of the Master Plan.
