






Separate Carts



Income Level




Age Group

Recycling Barriers: By Income Level






No major differences between income groups

- 30% of respondents ages 18 to 44 want to learn more about how to recycle right


Recycling Right



Most respondents considered Cardboard, Plastic Container, Metal Cans, Glass Containers, and Office Paper acceptable for recycling.


Most respondents do not consider Used Pizza Boxes and Plastic Bags recyclable.

Items Considered Allowed for Recycling





Age Group




- Renters/Multi-Family are more likely to say they do not receive recycling information from their city
- Email followed by direct mail are the most preferred methods of communication

High Unemployment Zip Codes



(33069, 33023, 33309, 33311, 33313, 33319)

- 91% of respondents have separate carts for garbage and recycling
- 61% of respondents recycle now and follow guidelines
- One-third want to learn more
 - (22% was overall response rate)
- 79% of respondents currently receive recycling information from their city



157 responses (47% response rate via YouTube ads) \$1230 = 331 clicks
