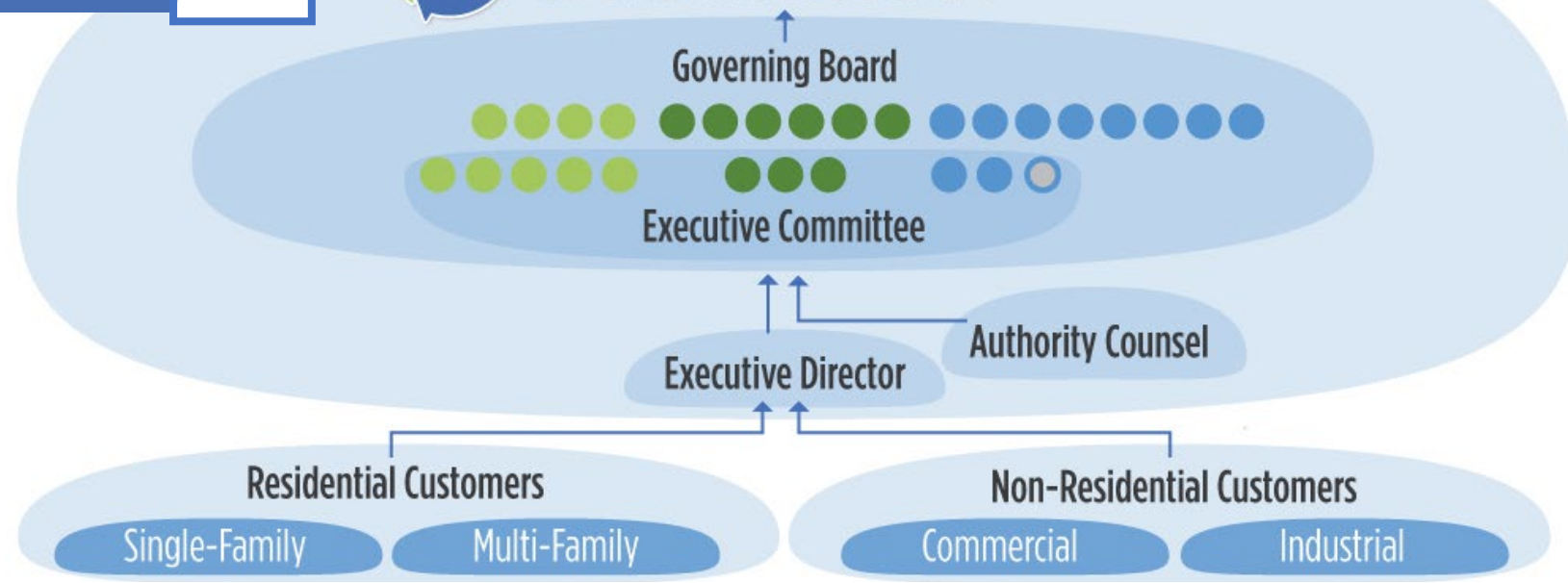

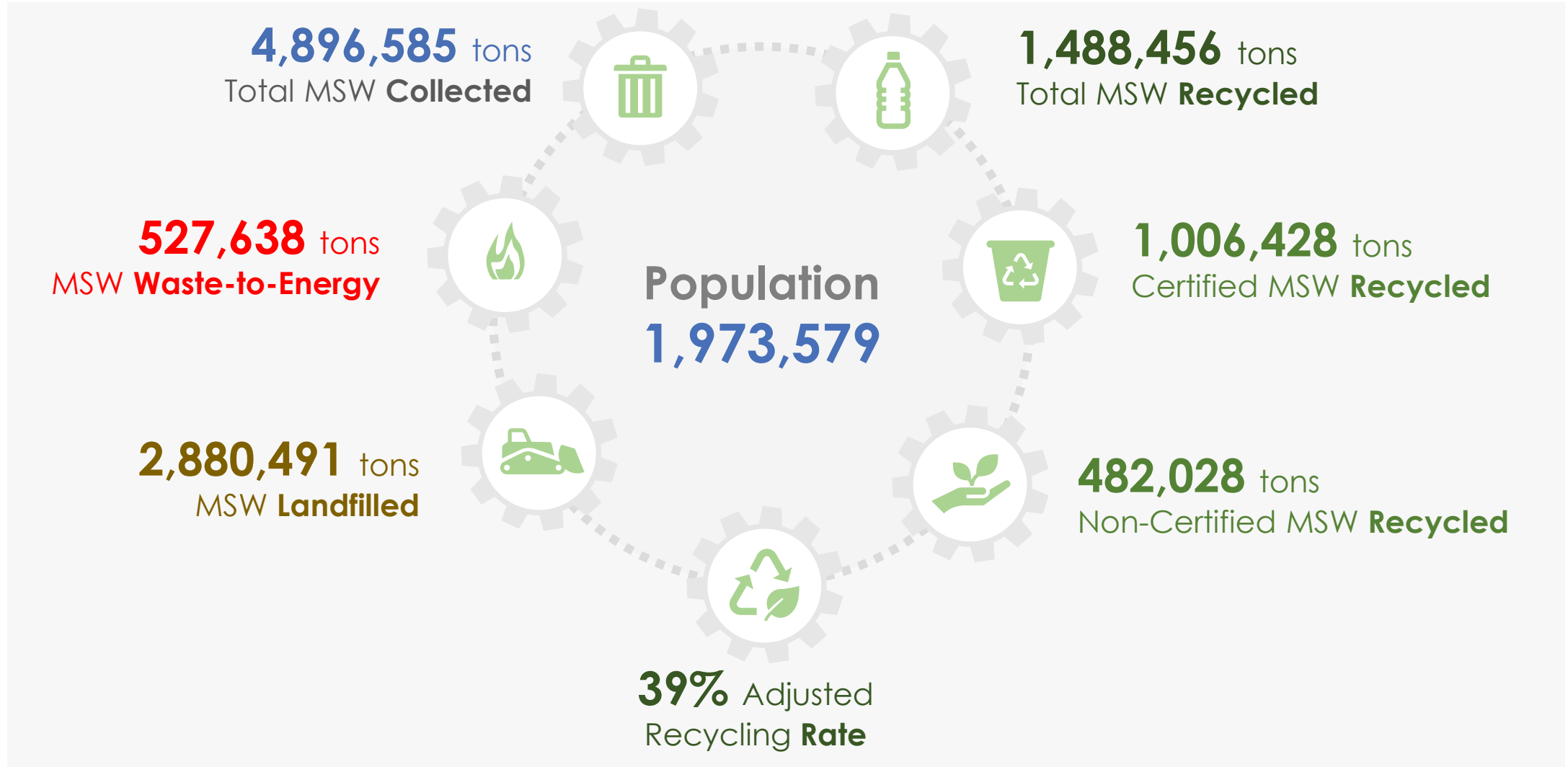

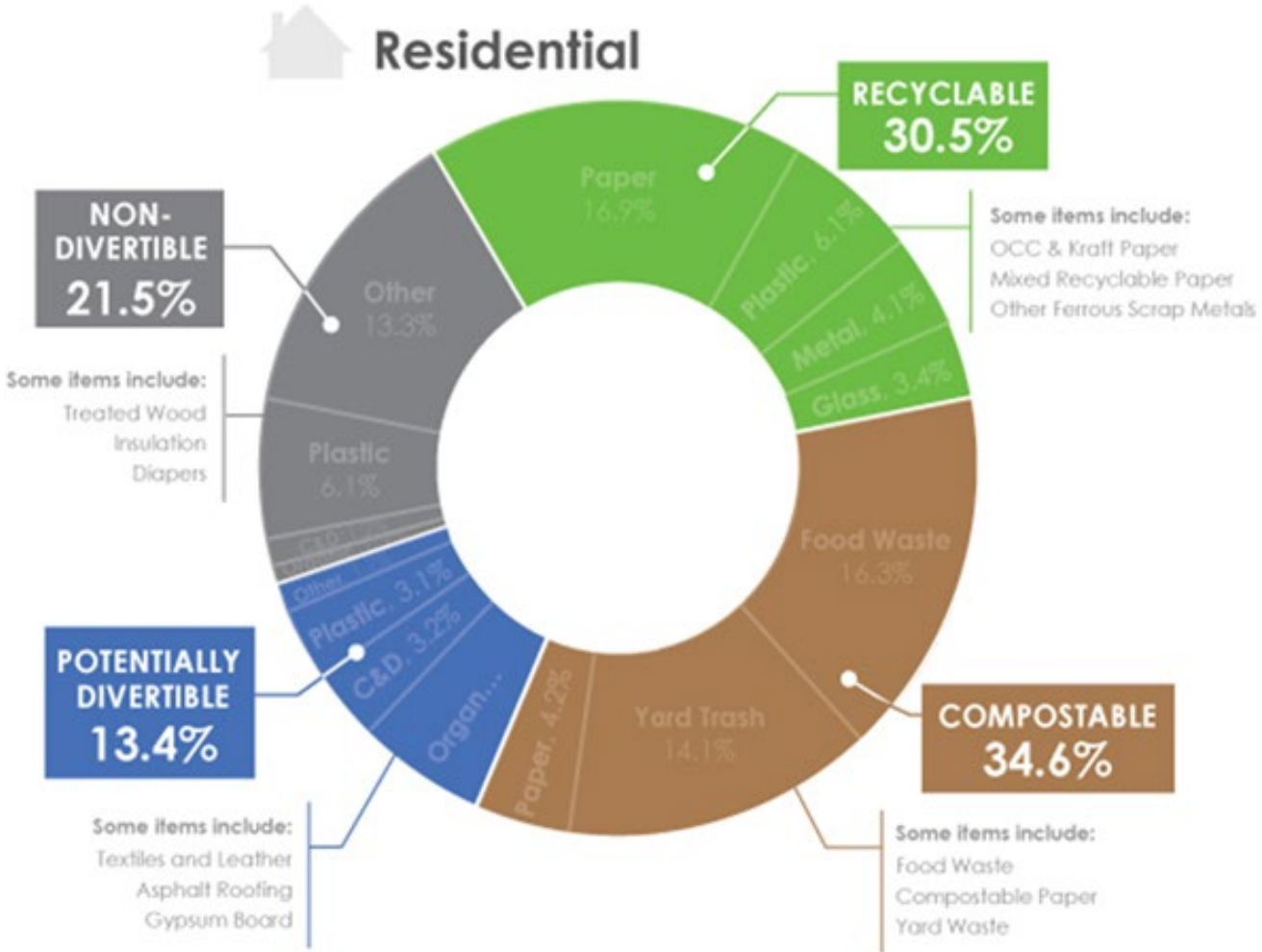

Final Disposition of Municipal Solid Waste (2023)





Request for Proposals

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Residential Curbside Recycling

Prepare and issue an RFP for one or more qualified Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) operators to receive, sort, and market curbside recyclables collected by the Parties or their contracted haulers.



Residential Yard Waste

Prepare and issue an RFP for third-party operator(s) to receive, grind, and compost or mulch vegetative waste (i.e., yard trash) from municipal curbside collections.



Long-Term Disposal for Municipal Solid Waste

Prepare and issue an RFP for a third party or parties to provide adequate long-term disposal capacity (e.g., waste-to-energy, landfill) to meet the needs of the Authority.
