### WM Recycling Oakes Road and WM Recycling Deerfield Capabilities & Highlights

- Multiple certified scales at both facilities creating improved turnaround for our customers
  utilizing the facility for disposal of C&D debris and material pickup
- Tipping floors capable of safely receiving **8-10 consecutive shipments** with traffic directors on site for employee and customer safety
- Our primary "A" Lines have sorting capacity to separate up to 6 different products in storage bunkers
- Our secondary "B" Lines are equipped with cross magnets for metal collection, one mechanical trommel, two destoner machines, and a final vibratory screen to automate sorting of material fractions < 2 feet</li>
- With location in both the North and South ends of Broward County, the two sites represent a strategic and logistical footprint.
- Capabilities available for concrete recycling creating Recycled Concrete Aggregate (RCA) for use in local infrastructure and building projects.

#### WM Recycling South Florida Facility Capabilities and Highlights

- 127,000 square feet inclusive of the administration building.
- A 1,400 square foot Sustainability Education Room suitable for municipal and commercial customers, civic and school group tours with a catwalk exit from the room to view the entire plant from an elevated and safe space.
- WM Recycling South Florida will have dual lines for redundancy capable of processing 60 tons per operating hour.
- Annual capacity will be increased by at least 28% 35% to more than 275,000 tons per year.
- Two trailer tippers for improved service and turnaround for our customers that utilize transfer stations for deliveries.
- Four balers including one dedicated to baling plastic film.
- Eight outbound loading docks for baled commodities heading to market for sale.
