Good Afternoon

The city of Deerfield Beach is the sole hauler for both commercial and residential trash, bulk waste, and C&D. Our main concerns regarding the Potential C&D Recycling Ordinance and Program are as follows:

An increase in operational costs, for both hauling and disposal, will affect the demand for more collection trucks, which in turn correlates with a rise in staffing. When a new stream is added at the curbside or construction sites, it will result in more trucks on the road. Furthermore, disposal trip times will likely double or triple because we will need to send our C&D, bulk veg, etc., much farther outside city limits. The last thing we want is to pass these increased costs on to our residents and businesses.
